NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the 2009 - 2012 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the Club 420 Class rules except as altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. BOATS:

Club 420s will be provided by WCSC, or, bring your own borrowed Club 420 from a sailing school owned fleet; privately owned boats will not be permitted. Spinnaker and Trapeze shall not be used.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

A "school team" consists of two sailors. Competing schools must be located in the state of Minnesota. Schools may enter as many teams as they wish. Teams should be from the same school; mixed teams will be permitted but scored as only one school. No student below the level of 7th grade shall be eligible to compete. Individual Club 420 class membership not required.

4. ENTRY:

The entry deadline is Friday, May 29, 2009 at 6:00 PM. Entries will be accepted after this deadline, **the late entry fee is \$50 per team.**
